#### Let's learn about birds!

- · Birds have feathers instead of hair.
- Wings allow birds to fly, and their bones are hollow so that they are extra light.
- Some birds, like penguins, are flightless.
- Birds have hard beaks for digging into the ground or trees for food, or for defending themselves.
- Baby birds don't come from their mommy's tummy like we do. Instead, the mommy bird builds a nest and lays an egg. After the baby bird is ready, they will hatch from the egg.





Do the Penguin Waddle

Ask mom or dad to find you a tennis ball. Clench the ball between your feet. Now try to walk without letting the ball roll away. Look at you! You're doing the penguin waddle!

#### Bouncy Eggs?

**Eggshell** is made of **calcium carbonate**, the main stuff in **chalk**. For a fun science experiment, place an egg in a glass & cover with vinegar. Let the egg sit overnight. The next day, the shell will have dissolved and you'll be able to gently bounce it on a plate. But don't bounce it too hard, or you'll make a big mess!
