Ms. Frizzle and the Magic School Bus gang are at it again, only this time on the moon! Explore the lunar surface, create moon sand to take home, and make moon craters.

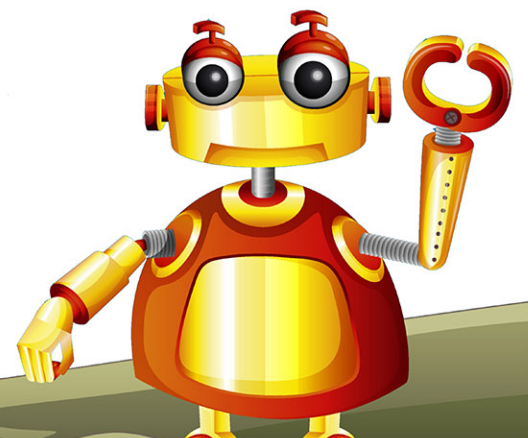
July 11: *Benihana Kabuki Sushi (Registration Required)*

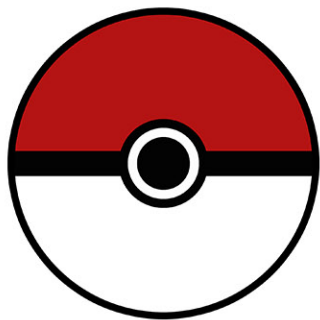
