### June 27: Drones to the Rescue

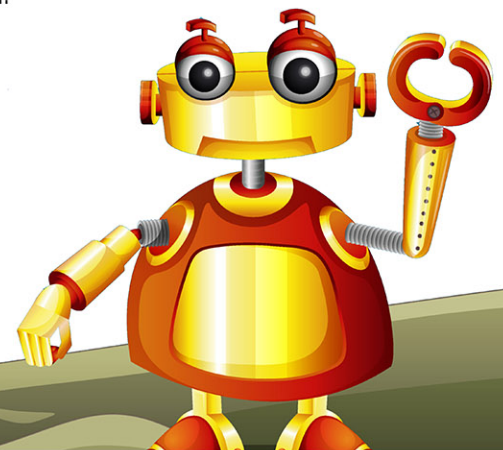

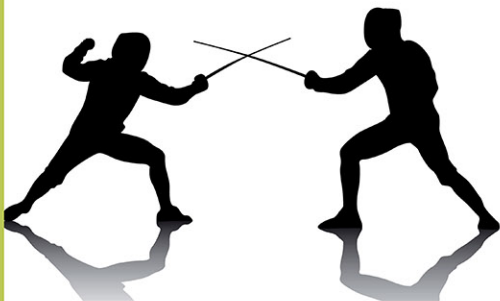
