





Make a Bird Feeder

Supplies: pipe cleaners, Cheerios™ Cereal (or similar shaped cereal), string/yarn/ribbon

- Fold the 1st pipe cleaner in half, then unfold it. That fold becomes the top of your heart.
- 2. Thread the Cheerios[™] onto your pipe cleaner. Leave a little space at the end so you have some room to work with.
- 3. Carefully bend your 1st pipe cleaner into the shape of a heart. Twist the ends of the pipe cleaner to close it.
- 4. Repeat steps 1 and 2.
- 5. Carefully bend your 2nd pipe cleaner into the shape of a heart but this time connect the hearts first and THEN twist the ends of the pipe cleaner to close the 2nd heart.
- 6. Attach string, yarn, or ribbon to the top and find a nice spot to hang it outside.



























Two Little Blackbirds
