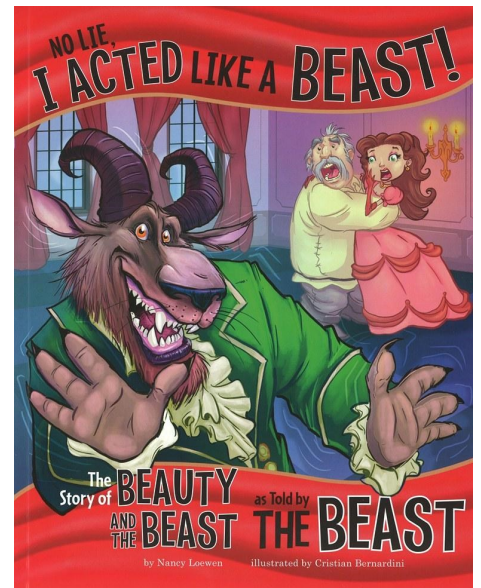

STEM @ HOME: COOKING

When you learn to cook, you learn the science of food and nourishment; you learn to plan, measure, calculate, observe, predict, use tools...and so much more.

You will love this smooth, easy dessert made with vanilla and chocolate pudding mix, milk, cool whip, and chocolate cookie crumble and topped with sprinkles!!

PREP

5 Min

COOK

15 Min

Ingredients:

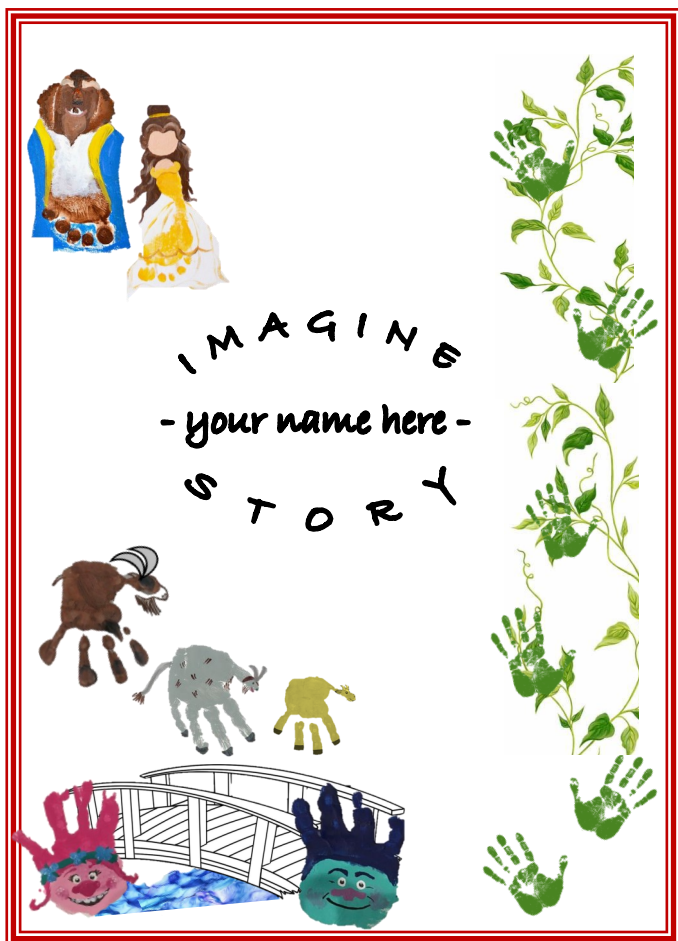
- 1 1/2 cups of cold whole milk
- 1 (3.4 ounce) package of instant vanilla pudding mix
- 15 chocolate cookie sandwiches
- 1 (8 ounce) container whipped topping, thawed
- 3 tablespoons instant chocolate pudding mix
- 12 sugar cookies

Directions:

1. Pour milk into a large mixing bowl. Add instant vanilla pudding mix and whisk for 2 minutes until smooth and slightly thickened. Place in the refrigerator for 1-2 hours, until firm.
2. Put chocolate sandwich cookies in food processor & pulse until pureed, or put in a bag and crush with rolling pin.
3. Fold pureed cookies into pudding mix. Stir until fully mixed.
4. Add whipped topping and instant chocolate pudding. Stir until fully mixed.
5. Place in refrigerator and chill for one hour.
6. Spoon grey stuff into piping bag fitted with desired tip, or use a Ziplock bag with a small hole cut out. Pipe grey stuff onto sugar cookies.
7. Enjoy your very own grey stuff, because as Lumiere says, "It's delicious!"

Week 3 Extra Activity: ← - - - - -

Story Towel you will need a towel for each family member
(adding to your story towel from the previous weeks)

Supplies needed: Permanent markers Acrylic paint

Colors needed: black, brown, tan, white, beige, yellow, blue or child's choice of colors

Use the brown paint on your child's right foot to stamp the shape of the Beast. Use yellow (or color of choice) paint on your child's left foot to stamp the shape of Belle's dress. Let dry and if you would like, continue to add details like in the picture to enhance your characters.

Allow to dry then store for next storytime with Ms. Crystal. You will be adding to this towel!

The moral of Beauty and the Beast is that we should value inward characteristics such as kindness over other superficial qualities, such as wit and appearance.
