STEM IDEA: Simple Machines– Wedges

Paper Gingerbread Man cut out

Other Supplies from Home:

- 1 foot square piece of aluminum foil
- Tub of water large enough to float
- aluminum foil boat across
- Scissors
- Crayons or markers
