

## Accelerated Reader (AR) Books

Every AR book has a point value based on its readability and length. Students take quizzes about the AR book and earn points based on the book's point value and correct answers.

The first number indicates the grade level. For example, 3.9 means the 9 month of 3rd grade. The second number indicates the point value of the book. For example, .5 means a half point.

Longer and more complex books are worth more points. For example, if the book had a point value of .5 and 5 correct answers are given, he/she would receive .5 points. If the student incorrectly answered one question, he/she would receive .4 points.

If your child finds the quizzes too easy, they can challenge themselves by trying a book at a higher ATOS Level. Books at higher levels reward more points.
